3. state driver's license/permit for each player. No player will be allowed to play in older age brackets due to the safety of the younger players. There is a 10-player maximum per roster, and the 12-14' and 15-18 year olds must provide

a current photo ID.

Saturday, March 23. First game starts at 8 a.m.

Six to eight coed teams; \$100 entry-fee; 8-team limit; double elimination/one game championship.
