Sunday the closing ceremony will be at 10am. For more information contact LeMinnie Smith at 541-325-1531.

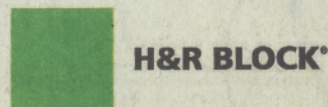
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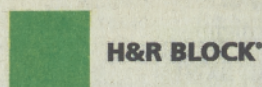
