



## Court voids death sentence in Indian country

OKLAHOMA CITY (AP) – A federal appeals court has reversed the death sentences of an Oklahoma man who pleaded guilty to three counts of first-degree murder because the crimes occurred in Indian country and the state lacked the au-

thority to prosecute him. Last week's ruling by the 10th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals voided David Magnan's convictions, but the judges said they would expect new charges from federal prosecutors. Magnan pleaded guilty in

Seminole County District Court to three counts of first-degree murder in connection with the 2004 shooting deaths of three people in rural Seminole County. He was sentenced to death on each count. Magnan is an enrolled

member of the Fort Peck Assiniboine and Sioux Tribes. He appealed, claiming the crimes occurred on Indian land and that, therefore, Oklahoma could not prosecute him.

## Chance for casino in Catskills, other NY regions

ALBANY, N.Y. (AP) – The lucrative prize of a New York City casino remains off the table for now, but some gambling interests would still take a chance under new legislation that would allow four upstate casinos.

State lawmakers are poised to vote as early as Friday on a measure that would authorize Las Vegas-style resort casinos in three upstate areas: the Catskills-Hudson Valley region, the Southern Tier near Binghamton and the Albany-Saratoga Springs corridor. The New York City area would be off limits to casinos for seven years to give the upstate resorts time to build up business.

Nothing can happen unless an amendment to the state constitution allowing full casinos on

non-Indian land is approved by voters in November. But gambling interests eyeing upstate casinos were still buoyed by the end-of-session deal between Gov. Andrew Cuomo and lawmakers.

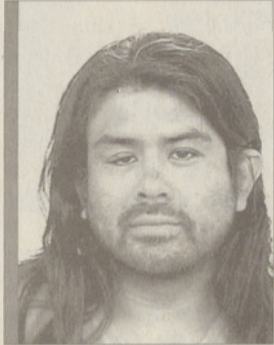
"We're very encouraged," said Foxwoods Resort Casino President and CEO Scott Butera. "We've always said we wanted more than one casino in the Catskills area. I think this opens the door for that."

Foxwoods officials announced this month that they and Muss Development of New York City are prepared to build a \$300 million-plus casino resort next to the former Grossinger's Hotel, a mainstay from the Catskill's Borscht Belt heyday a few generations ago.

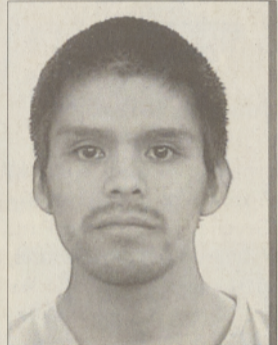
## 2 men sentenced in Seattle man's death

Two Warm Springs men were each sentenced to 24 years in prison for the beating death of a Seattle fisherman whose body was found in May 2012 near Warm Springs.

Circuit Judge Annette Hillman imposed the sentences earlier this month on 24-year-old Steven Neal Anderson Jr. and 32-year-old James Ryan Johnson in the killing of

Dennis Michael Jones. The victim's body was found near a popular fishing spot south of the Warm Springs Indian Reservation.

Jefferson County District Attorney Steve Leriche says the two apologized to Jones' relatives before pleading guilty to first-degree manslaughter and kidnap charges.
