Santos was an activist, painter, sculptor, serigrapher, and writer who left a legacy of creative vision for the indigenous world.

The Santos family was in attendance, including mother Lena Tewee Santos who had never seen some of the paintings displayed in the exhibit.

Santos' paintings and serigraphs often contain the dramatic and diverse landscape and sky of the High Desert. Snowstorms and the elements of wind, water, sun and moon appear with vigor.
