

Kitchen fire causes damage at KNT

A fire in the kitchen area last week at Kah-Nee-Ta caused smoke, fire and water damage, and forced the resort to close its main lodge.

A wild-land fire near the resort then broke out two days later, forcing the evacuation of guests.

Regarding the kitchen fire, Warm Springs Fire Chief Dan Martinez said the only reported injury was to a cook, who suffered second-degree arm burns.

After the kitchen fire, more than 350 people were evacuated and moved to other hotels. Martinez says guests were never in danger, but firefighters had to turn off the power grid because water got into that.

The resort announced that the lodge would be closed for four days; then on Saturday the wild-land blaze broke out, requiring evacuation.
