These notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs.

Request for release of funds

On or about September 6, 2013 the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs will submit a request to the Department of Housing and Urban Development for the release of Imminent Threat ICDBG, Grant #B-

11SR411424 funds under Title I/Section 106(a)(1) of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 to undertake a project known as the Simnasho Water Source Construction, for the purpose of supplying water to the community that meets the new arsenic standards by developing a new well, construction of a new pump house and treatment building with installation of submersible well pump and installing a new connection to the Beaver Creek Well Field. The project location starts at the W-100/US 26 intersection and proceeds southerly on the west side of US 26 to BIA Route 9 then proceeds southeast along the southern side of BIA Route 9 and ends at the Beaver Creek/BIA Route 9 intersection. The overall cost of the project is estimated at \$3,370,000; IHS/EPA Commitment is \$2,572,781.00, HUD ICDBG Grant \$450,000.00 and the balance belonging to the Tribe.

Finding of no significant impact

The Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR) on file at the Public Utilities Office located at 2251 Rehab Street, Warm Springs, Oregon, 97761 or at the Tribal Administration Building, Department of Contracts & Grants, 1233 Veterans Street, Warm Springs, Oregon, 97761 for review and may be examined or copied weekdays (M-F) 8 A.M. to 4:30 P.M.

Public comments

Any individual, group, or agency disagreeing with this determination or wishing to

comment on the project may submit written comments to the Public Utilities Office, P.O. Box 1196, Warm Springs, Oregon, 97761 to the attention of Travis Wells. All comments received by September 5, 2013 will be considered by the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Comments should specify which Notice they are addressing.

Release of funds

The Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs certifies to HUD that Jake O. Suppah in his capacity as Secretary-Treasurer consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. HUD's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and

related laws and authorities, and allows the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs to use Program funds.

Objections to release of funds

HUD will accept objections to its release of funds and the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs; (b) the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58; (c) the grant recipient has committed funds or incurred costs not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by HUD; or (d) another Federal

agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58) and shall be addressed to HUD at Department of Housing and Urban Development, NwONAP-Seattle Federal Office Building, 909 First Avenue, Suite 300, Seattle, Washington, 98104-1000. Potential objectors should contact HUD to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
