Jim Manion, Power Enterprise, with PGPV LLC, Peter Greenberg, developer, to operate Solar Photovoltaic Energy System to provide power to the Warm Springs Administration Building. Located on tribal land situated at The Agency area, described as: NW1/4SW1/4 of Section 26, Township 9 South, Range 12 East, Willamette Meridian, Jefferson County, Oregon, containing 2.0 acres more or less. A Business lease will be issued by BIA Realty pending Tribal Council approval.

The lease term will be for 15 years, at which time ownership of the solar panels will be turned over to the Tribes. PGPV LLC will apply for grant monies to complete the project. There will be no cost to the Tribes to install the panels. The panels will put out 300 KW of power to be used by the Administration Building. The developer will pay for 15 years insurance guarantee and when ownership is turned over to the Tribes will pay an additional 20 years insurance. There will be an annual rental of \$16,000 paid to the Tribes. The developer will maintain the panels and will train personnel to take over maintenance. The panels are placed on a railing system and a robot will travel along the rail to adjust each panel for angle and direction.

Brandie McNamee, Asst. Controller, with Ellen Grover, Tribal Attorney, have been collaborating the details of an agreement with the developer.
