noon to 1 p.m.

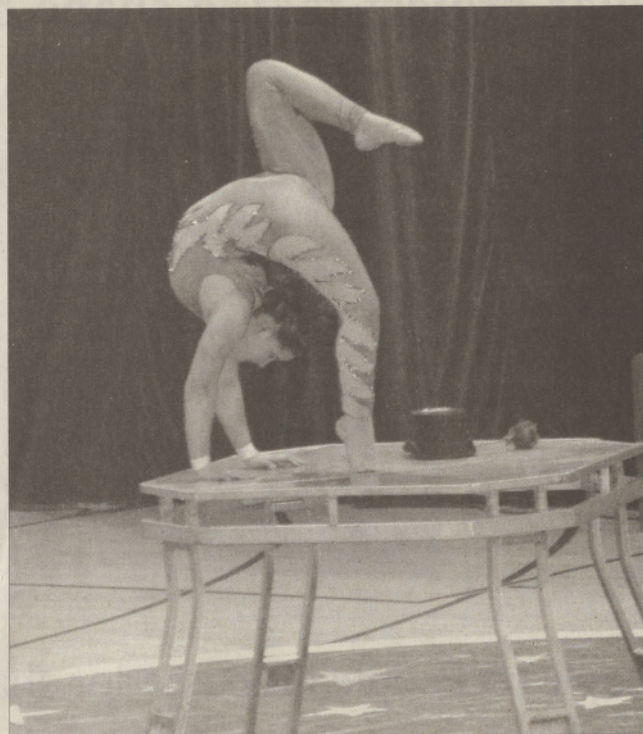
The conference will be on Wednesday, Nov. 20 in the Community Center Social Hall.
