## Cobell payments in early 2014

The *Cobell vs. Salazar* Settlement Agreement approved by Congress and the courts requires identification of all Trust Administration class members, and calculation of their respective pro rata shares by the Department of the Interior.

This must occur before the Garden City Group, the claims administrator for the Cobell Settlement, can mail Trust Administration Class payments. That work is ongoing and is nearly complete.

After the membership of

the Trust Administration Class is finalized, it will take Interior approximately a month to complete the calculations for the over 500,000 Trust Administration Class Members.

Once the Garden City Group receives these calculations and the court approves the Second Stage Distribution, the Garden City Group will quickly prepare and commence distribution within three weeks.

Thus, if the class membership is finally determined in

December, the payments can be made in the first quarter of 2014 barring any unexpected issues.
