Over \$6,000 in cultural grants awarded through Washanaksha program

The Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs Washanaksha Cultural Committee has selected the recipients of their 2014 grants.

The Washanaksha awards go to tribal members for projects that promote understanding of and involvement in cultural activities, that pass on tribal knowledge to youth, that support artists and traditional teachers or that preserve, practice and teach tribal language.

More than \$6,000 has been allocated to members for the 2014 projects, described as follows:

Matilda Wallulatum will be offering moccasin making and earring making at the Simnasho Longhouse.

Starla Green will be making root digging

"kupuns" and will teach others how to make them too.

The Warm Springs Culture and Heritage Department will be offering six workshops for 11-15 year old young men that focus on traditional male roles.

Suzie Slockish will improve the teaching of Ichishkin, and the documenting traditional practices.

Emily Yazzie will teach young people how to make items needed for traditional practices.

Gerald Danzuka will offer sessions to male youth on tribal history, leadership, tribal Language and historical dances.

Projects can begin in January 2014, and need to be completed by July.

Grant funding is sponsored by the Oregon Cultural Trust.
