

# K-8 Academy construction

The Warm Springs K-8 Academy is on schedule for completion in four months: The completion date is estimated at July 18.

One area of the 80,000-square-foot school—the classrooms for the kindergarten through second grades—are already painted on the inside.

Meanwhile, construction workers are preparing the water line that will serve the school. A new water tower will be constructed near the existing one, and the line will follow Chukar and then cut across a lot to the school. A good view of the school is from the main bus entrance area, off Tenino.

The weather has been good lately, allowing for the work to continue at a good pace. Kirby Nagelhout Construction Co. of Bend is the general contractor on the \$20 million project.
