

## Fishing open at Sherars

Fishing is open to tribal members at Sherars Bridge until mid July.

Only hatchery salmon and steelhead may be kept. Sockeye salmon must be returned until the run has recovered.

The hatchery fish are identified by the lack of the adipose fin. Fishing is allowed from scaffolding or by hook and line. Scaffolding should

be attended at all times. Fishing net or hoop must be attached to a pole.

This is a subsistence fishery and no sales are allowed. Fish must be made available to Branch of Natural Resource staff, or other designated official for monitoring and enforcement. If you have questions call Natural Resources at 541-553-2001.
