

### Cascade East Transit service returns

Cascades East Transit has returned to providing bus service to Warm Springs.

A couple of years ago the company, which operates under the Central Oregon Intergovernmental Council, provided local bus service, and trips between Madras and Warm Springs.

Warm Springs Transit then took over responsibility for the public transit system, and added additional stops and an adjusted schedule.

The Cascades East Transit bus returned to Warm Springs earlier this month, and is working on a revised schedule.

Details are forthcoming about routes and times for

the new bus service.

### Tribal Council, school board meet on education issues

The Tribal Council was set to host a work session on Tuesday of this week, Jan. 20, with the 509-J Board (the meeting was after the print deadline for this publication).

A topic on the agenda was the next "memorandum of agreement for education services" between the tribes and the school district.

The current agreement runs for another two years, but important matters require long-term planning, said Rick Molitor, school district superintendent.

#### Impact aid hearing

There was a recurring theme among several who commented at the Impact Aid hearing in December, Molitor said.

The theme was local control of school matters for Native students.

With the memorandum of agreement coming up for renewal in two years, the time is right for consideration of how best to achieve this goal, Molitor said.

The meeting on Tuesday of this week was scheduled at Kah-Nee-Ta. Other subjects on the agenda were:

Busing at the Warm Springs Eagle Academy; Impact Aid review, compliance and uses.

Title VII review, compliance and uses. Johnson O'Malley review and uses. In other news from the school board meeting last week:

- The school district is now in compliance with the Impact Aid requirements, and

is expecting soon to receive the full amount as budgeted. There had been some delay in this, as the compliance was being reviewed.

- The December Impact Aid hearing was the most successful in terms of receiving input from parents and teachers of the Warm Springs community, Molitor said.

- The school board accepted a donation of football gear, valued at \$10,000, for Madras High School. The donation comes from Jesuit High School.

- The board accepted a \$10,000 from Central Oregon Seeds Inc., to be used for the new track and field at Madras High School.

### Board positions coming up for election

Jefferson County will conduct the special districts election in May.

The election will decide two positions on the Jefferson County School District 509-J Board of Directors; plus positions on the Jefferson County Library District board, the Madras Aquatic Center board, Education Services District

board, and other special district boards in the county.

A person can file to run for one of the positions up until March 19. The first day to file to run is February 7. Potential candidates must file a candidacy form with the Jefferson County. There is a \$10 filing fee; or the person can submit valid signatures of 25 registered voters in the

county.

There are two positions of five positions on the Jefferson County 509-J School district board coming up for election in May 19 vote. The positions currently held by Bradley Holliday and Stan Sullivan are up for election.

The elected board members will take office in July.
