The Mark O. Hatfield Fellowship was established in 1998 as a living tribute to Senator Hatfield. Each year one Native American is selected to be the Hatfield Fellow and serve as a member of the staff of one of Oregon's representatives in Congress in Washington, DC.

This internship lasts for nine months. The fellowship was established by the Grand Ronde tribes.

Hatfield Fellows learn the inner workings of the federal political system and serve as

advisors on Native American issues. They work closely with their member of Congress and with the entire Oregon Congressional delegation.

Hatfield Fellows are capable, motivated individuals, who, through their work in Washington, acquire new skills and experiences to be change makers and leaders in their communities, producing long-term benefits for all of the tribes and the Pacific Northwest.

Fellows also participate in the American Political Science Association's (APSA) month-long fellowship orientation. During this time, APSA fel-

lows in journalism, political science and international policy become acclimated to the environment in Washington, DC.

By collaborating with APSA, Fellows have an instant support network, including the director of the fellowship program who acts as a resource and a mentor.

Past fellows have successfully served in several congressional offices over the years, including Sens. Ron Wyden and Gordon Smith, and Representatives David Wu, Darlene Hooley, Earl Blumenauer and Greg Walden.
