The Warm Springs Community Action Team, along with Tribal Credit Enterprise and Warm Springs Housing Authority, are co-teaching new sessions of Pathways Home, Indianpreneurship, and Financial Skills for Families.

These sessons begin the week of April 18.

Pathways Home is a seven week course that walks you through the steps to buying a house. This course covers

mortgages, financial planning, and maintaining a home. The course will be offered on Tuesdays from 5:30-7:30 beginning April 19 at Tribal Credit Enterprise.

Indianpreneurship is a 10module course that walks you through starting a business.

Topics include research, marketing, finance, and writing a business plan. Classes will take place on Mondays and Thursdays beginning May

Classes will be from 5:30-7:30 at Tribal Credit Enterprise.

Financial Skills for Families is a six-session course that walks you through maintaining a budget, coming up with a savings plan, and understanding credit. This class, beginning April 27, will be taught on Wednesdays from 5:30-7:30 at the Warm Springs Community Action Team office.
