Volleyball at Youth Center

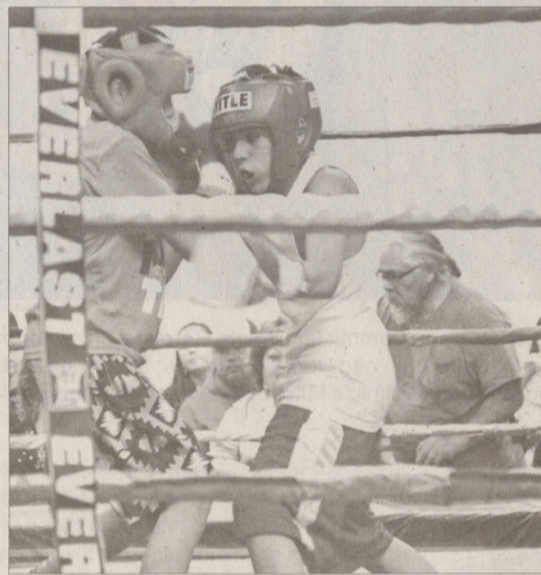
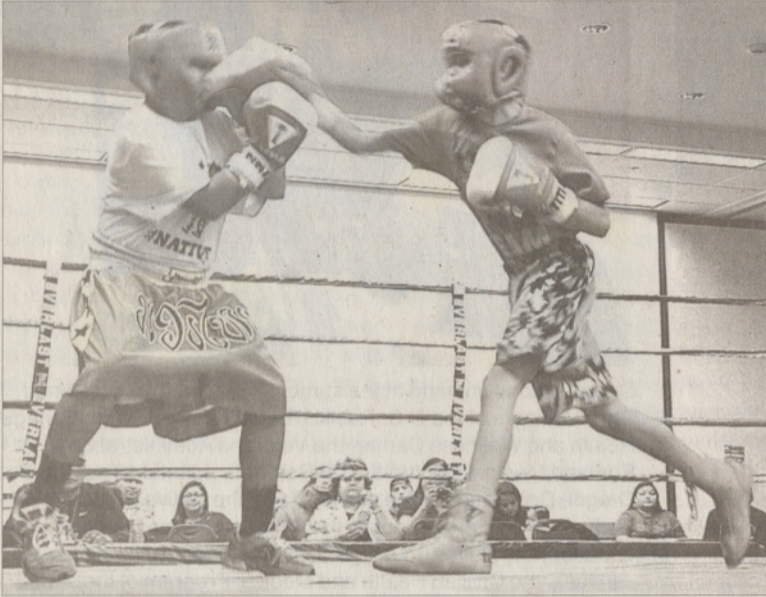
A volleyball clinic and open gym volleyball are held every Tuesday and Thursday through December at the Warm Springs Youth Center.

The youth clinic is from 5:15-6 p.m. Tuesdays and Thursdays; and the open gym is from 6-7 p.m.

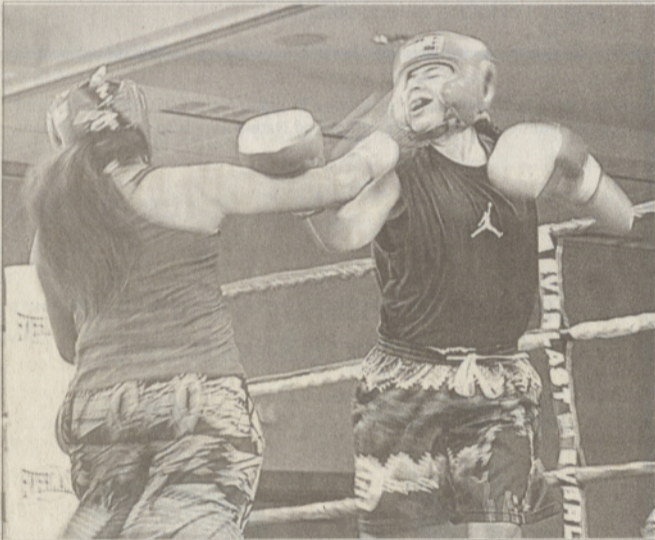
Boys and girls ages 7-17 are invited to participate in the clinic.
