

Senator, Congressman plan visits

Congressman Walden is on the Tribal Council agenda for Tuesday, March 3. A main topic of discussion during his visit to Warm Springs is the opiate epidemic, according to the Council agenda for April.

The next day, Wednesday,

April 4, Sen. Merkley is planning Town Hall meetings at IHS and at the Warm Springs Academy, the Council agenda says.

Report: Sea lions now in tributaries

Sea lions are beginning to move into even smaller Northwest river tributaries where they had never been seen before, according to Oregon wildlife managers.

In these tributaries the sea lions are threatening some of the healthiest stocks of the salmon and steelhead fish.

The sea lions have also been spotted in small rivers

in Washington state.

Biologists this spring started trapping the sea li-

ons in the Willamette River and releasing them at the coast.
