

CPS building ready for open house

The Warm Springs community is invited to an open house and blessing of the wholly renovated Children's Protective Services building.

The open house will be this Friday, March 30 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

The CPS building is new in that the interior and exterior have been completely renovated: New floors and ceilings, windows, paint, furniture, and exterior improvements.

Renovation of the CPS building was a long-standing need of the tribes. "We need a space as safe and

The original idea for CPS, back in 2010, was to build a new facility, and at the time

Then last year tribal management, CPS and Council weighed the options, and decided on a renovation of the existing building, plus the addition of an adjacent transition facility in the Vern Jackson, also remodeled.

The CPS work began last winter, done by Warm Springs Construction.

They were putting finishing touches up until a couple of weeks ago, and the building is now complete.

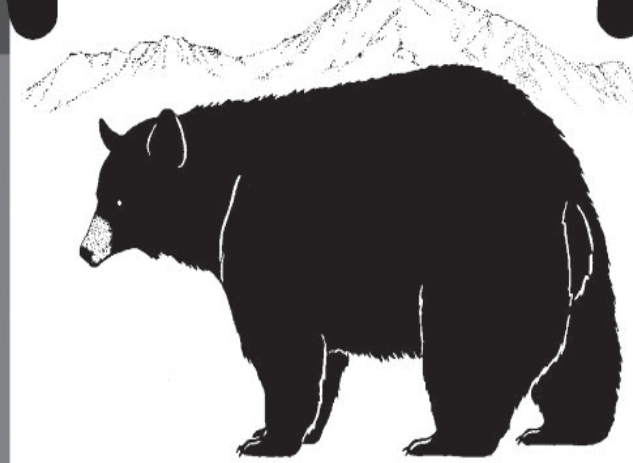
