

The ordinance protects the Warm Springs community, while providing due process for all individuals.

The ordinance provides for possible detention for those who are infectious, or possibly infectious, but choose to travel out of their place of isolation or quarantine.

For now the tribal organization remains closed, excepting essential employees and services, through Monday, August 3. Tribal Council will review the situation this Friday, July 31 with the Covid-19 Response Team.

Water

The boil water notice is still in effect for Warm Springs Agency area.

Drinking water distribution is Monday through Friday 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the former elementary school. Each individual can receive one gallon of water per day. Exchanges for five-gallon water jugs are allowed.

To limit risk, the Emergency Department water distribution staff can no longer refill water jugs or gallons. Showers are avail-

able 6 a.m. to 9 p.m.

The water available for the Agency community is still low.

Utilities construction is scheduled to begin within the next two weeks on the water line. Be forewarned that water will have to be shut off for a day, or two days at the most for repairs. The shut-off days will be announced, so all can prepare with storage of water at home.
