

## Projected slowdown in state covid cases

The state Health Authority released its latest Covid-19 forecast, showing a continued decline in daily cases and hospitalizations projected through mid October.

At the estimated level of

transmission, now slower than in September, the report estimates 320 cases per 100,000 people, or an average of 955 daily cases and 56 hospitalizations for the period between this Thurs-

day, October 7 through October 19.

Under that scenario, the pace of newly diagnosed cases and hospitalizations would be considerably lower than in September.

## Covid spike from Round-Up slows progress

Oregon is experiencing a downward trend in Covid-19 hospitalizations and cases after a bad late-summer surge.

However, Gov. Kate Brown said last week she was "gravely concerned" about an outbreak in the northeastern part of the state following the Pendleton Round-Up rodeo.

So far, there have been at least 49 newly confirmed cases of Covid-19 tied to the annual rodeo, which attracted thousands of people to that corner of Oregon in mid-September.

Most of the cases were reported in Umatilla County, where the round-up takes place, and in nearby Wallowa County.

Joe Fiumara, Umatilla County's public health director, said some people who attended the rodeo were sick but chose to go anyway.
