Jefferson County School District 509J's groundbreaking ceremony celebrated the start of the Madras High School Soccer Complex construction. This project was made possible by voters supporting the November 2021 Bond. JCSD 509J Board Members, Superintendent Jay Mathisen, Principal Tony Summers, and MHS Soccer players tossed the first dirt before construction begins. The district will conduct a number of facility upgrades, including:

- · New field lights,
- · Expanded concrete pathways
- · Upgraded gates for security; and
- A new, 2,000 square-foot field house with concession space, restrooms, athlete locker rooms, and a shared coaches office.

The estimated completion date for the project is Fall 2023.



Enrollment is open for Mariposa Dual Language School. This is a research-based two-way immersion program model. Students learn two languages, English and Spanish. Half of their day is taught in Spanish and the other half is taught in English.


The school is expanding for the 23-24 school year.

District Librarian.


