Hear a Sahaptin number and recognize the written numeral.
Understand simple addition problems.
Express an amount of money or a number of years.
Ask and answer "how many" of something there is.

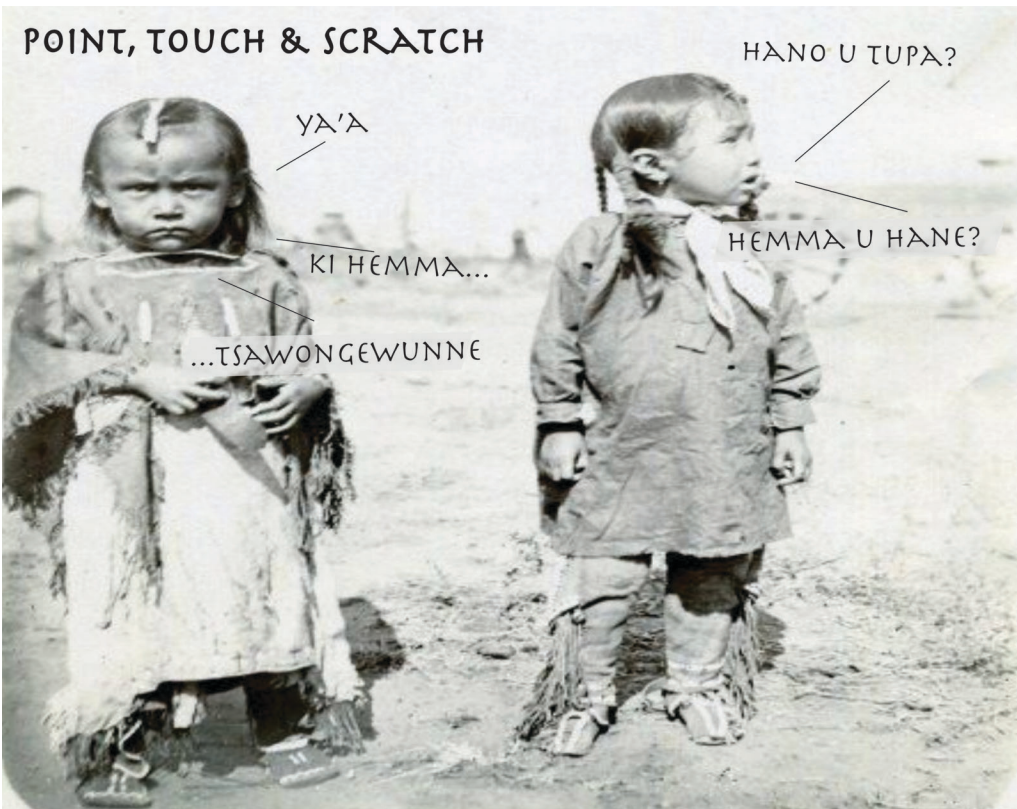
words expressing location in Wasco:

gigwal	below
šaxalix	above, over
qinq'iyám	right
qiq'ičqt	left
tıaxn	outside

All of these words are used with the suffix -ba on the following word; thus, "outside the house" is tıaxn itqwlíba, "over the river" is šaxalix wimalba, "below the table" is gigwal iladamba, "to the left of the chair" is qiq'ičqt alašišba, and so forth. Complete the following Wasco sentences as indicated:

- Mtwit (to the right of the table).
- Anułimčk agaıax (above the house).
- Aglga ak'ínułmat (under the chair).
- Uxwaima itk'ínułmat (to the left of the akwáıq).
