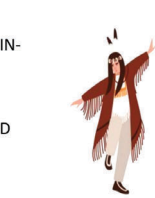
PROGRAM GOAL: To improve employment out comes for American Indians with disabilities by providing effective vocational rehabilitation services, by developing an IPE Individual Plan for Employment to reach a successful employment goal.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Current documentation of Disability.
- 2) CIB of Federally recognized tribe or Tribal ID.
- 3) Impediments or impairments (barriers) to maintain employment.
- 4) Consumer must live on or within the 65 mile service radius.
- 5) Consumer must have a reasonable expectation for VR to help reach employment goals.

Long sentence in domestic violence case

A repeat domestic abuser from Warm Springs, Alfred Dee Kaulaity, 47, was sentenced to federal prison in regard to a series of assaults on his girlfriend. Kaulaity also had seven prior convictions for similar offenses. He now faces 6 and one-half years in federal prison. This is in addition to a sentence that runs consecutive to a 7 and a half year stretch for a state domestic violence conviction in Jefferson County.

Kaulaity’s history of domestic violence goes back at least 17 years, involving multiple victims. The most recent victim “courageously turned in her abuser to stop his dangerous pattern of violence,” said Natalie Wight, U.S. Attorney

for the District of Oregon.
Aubree M. Schwartz, Acting Special Agent in Charge of the FBI Portland Field Office, added, “The FBI fully investigates domestic violence with intense commitment to the safety and confidentiality of victims and encourages reporting of these heinous crimes to bring offenders to justice and protect others from harm.”
The incident that led to the latest charges occurred on the reservaiton in December of 2020.
Kaulaity and his girlfriend were at the casino when he assaulted her for speaking to another man, leaving a scar on the bridge of her nose. Fleeing after the assault, they

went to northern California, where the girlfriend bought separate flights to ensure her escape and reporting the abuse in Portland.
Details from the case, recorded in court documents, allege Kaulaity kidnapped, assaulted, and nearly killed his girlfriend during the ordeal, a narrative corroborated by the victim’s accounts and airline employees who reported her injuries upon their arrival. On December 1, 2023, Kaulaity pleaded guilty to federal charges of domestic assault by a habitual offender.
