Warrant issued for man accused of destroying 18,000 juvenile salmon

Authorities in Douglas County have issued a warrant for the suspect in last month's destruction of 18,000 juvenile salmon at a Reedsport hatchery.

Joshua Alexander Heckathorn, 20, of Gardiner was a no-show at court earlier this month. He had been scheduled for his first court appearance, but told officials he had transportation issues and couldn't make it.

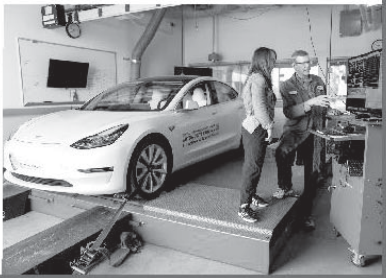
With his failure to make his re-

scheduled appearance, a Douglas County Circuit Court Judge issued a bench warrant for Heckathorn.

The warrant allows law enforcement to detain Heckathorn and bring him in on \$10,000 bail.

Heckathorn is accused of breaking into a Reedsport hatchery and pouring bleach into a tank with thousands of young Chinook salmon. He's charged with burglary, criminal trespass and criminal mischief.
