Anita L. Jackson, as Tribal Court Judge Pro Tempore, is authorized to hear and preside over cases in which a judge pro tempore is eligible to serve, and to which they may be assigned from time to time by the Chief Judge of the Tribal Court, and to perform all services required in such cases, with full authority in such matters as a Judge of the Warm Springs Tribal Court. The Secretary-Treasurer/CEO, or designees, are hereby directed and authorized to take any reasonable and necessary actions to carry out the purpose and intent of this resolution. Question: Jim/yes, Captain/yes, Jay/yes, Alvis/yes, Rosa/yes, 5/0/0, Chairman not voting. Motion carried.

• National Tribal Horse Coalition discussion with Michael Leecy and Tim Outman.

Motion by Jim adopting Resolution No. 13,158, with edits, consistent with Branch of Natural Resources responsibility of managing, preserving and enhancing the tribe’s natural, cultural and sovereign resources for the benefit of the Confederated Tribes and its tribal members, that Michael Leecy be appointed as Delegate and Joel ‘JE’ Florendo be appointed as Alternate to the National Tribal Horse Coalition, representing the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs. • Managed Care update with Michael Collins.

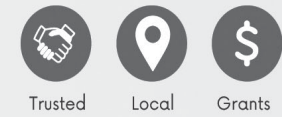

Financial aid for septic repairs



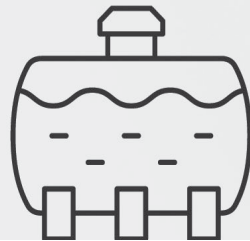
Visit our website to check your eligibility and apply!

Need support covering those high costs?

Grants available through the Central Oregon Septic Assistance Program may cover up to \$20,000 for a standard system or to connect to the sewer line and up to \$30,000 for an alternative system for repairs incurred after January 2023 for eligible households.
