Dog ordinance update

Reports of dog bite incidents on the Warm Springs Reservation are on the rise according to the tribes’ Branch of Public Safety.

Dog Control Ordinance No. 36 remains in effect, but the ordinance is more than 60 years old, dating back to 1962.

Public Safety will take the lead on addressing the need for an updated, and an effective system for enforcement with a goal of reducing or eliminating dog bite incidents.

Individuals and families should be aware that dogs that may bite are not always confined by their owners, or do not have an owner; so the community should be cautious when walking about in the community.

Dog owners need to be responsible for their pets: keep them safe, at home and confined if needed.

Be aware that any Ordinance violations can be subject to a fine or jail time, or both.

Anyone who is a victim of a dog bite should call the Warm Springs police dispatch at 911, and seek emergency medical services.
