Warm Springs Credit Board of Directors: Four positions, two tribal members, and two non-members. Members of the board must have a reputation for industry, dependability, honesty and integrity. It shall be an initial and continuing qualification for members of the board have no loan with the tribes that is in delinquent status.

Telco Board of Directors: Three positions, two tribal members, one non-member. Members should possess experience in telecommunications, private industry, finance, banking or some other field which would benefit the company. (Method

and time of submitting an application and resume, same as above.)

Warm Springs Tribal Employment Rights Office (TERO) Commission: Four positions. Any Indian 18 years and older who works or resides on the reservation is qualified to be appointed to the commission. (Method and time of submitting an application and resume, same as above.)

Warm Springs Composite Products Board of Directors: Two positions, one tribal member and one non-member. Board members should possess expertise in marketing, management, manufacturing, finance, banking or some other field that would benefit the company. (Method and time of submitting an application and resume, same as above.)

Education Committee: One tribal member position, and one tribal member alternate position. Serve as an advisory body to the Tribal Council on educational programs and opportunities for tribal members. Reviews and recommends educational services through tribal, state and federal agencies. Employees require supervisor approval to serve on committees—Please submit with letter and resume. (Method and time of submitting an application and resume, same as above.)
