Organization weather alerts

The Warm Springs tribal organization has a process for employees to determine if winter weather is making travel too hazardous for traveling to work. The hazard assessment might be enacted early in the morning, or during the workday itself.

To keep you informed, the tribes offer an alert system that communicates emergency information to employees and the general public.

This system is designed to send texts and e-mail messages to compatible devices in the event of an emergency situation.

The notification system will only be utilized for an emergency situation like a government shutdown due to inclement weather.
