I am sorry I broke Tribal law by driving while suspended and possession. I apologize to my family for the shame my actions have brought to our family name. I apologize to my wife Vernice Williams, who was directly impacted by my actions. I also want to say I am sorry for my actions and am working to better myself. **Alex J. Williams.**
