amended; That the Secretary of the Interior or his/her authorized representative is hereby requested to approve the per capita distribution plan outlined above on January 1, 2026; That the Secretary-Treasurer/CEO is hereby authorized to proceed with the schedule of per capita payments plan after its ap-

proval by the authorized office in accordance with authority contained in Article V, Section 1 (t), as amended, of the Constitution and By-Laws and section 8 of the Corporate Charter.
