

## GRAND RONDE ENROLLMENT PROJECT

Requests for applications for enrollment to be placed on the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde Tribal roll are now being accepted. Eligibility requirements are :

(A) Applicant was born on or before August 13, 1954 and was entitled on August 13, 1954, to be on the final membership roll but his or her name was not listed.

(B) Applicant was born after August 13, 1954 and is a de-cendant of a person whose name appears on the August 13, 1954 final membership roll.

(C) Applicant was born after August 13, 1954 and is a de-cendant of a person who is entitled to appear on the August 13, 1954 final membership roll.

In order to insure more accuracy in updating the Tribal roll, we are requesting members already enrolled, to re-enroll. This will help to correct mistakes such as wrong birth dates, names, etc. made on the 1954 final membership roll.
