We would like to remind you that the Senior Citizen Transportation program of The Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde Indians, is still an on-going program.

For those of you that live within the Grand Ronde and the town area of Willamina and have not used our program, we have a 1973 Ford station wagon available to you through appointments, that will take you to your requested destination. For your convenience and ours, we ask if possible, that you please call and schedule your ride one or two days ahead of time.

The areas that our Tribal car usually covers are: Portland, Salem, McMinnville, Dallas, Sheridan and Willamina. So, if you need a ride to the doctor, dentist, optometrist, bank, or need to do some general or grocery shopping, give us a call. We are listed as the Tribal Council - Outreach & Transportation, and our phone number is 879-5253.
