This is in the process at the present time and should be completed in mid-August.

The profile will be submitted to Mr. Aucoins' Staff for review and clarification. At that time we are prepared to request introduction of our bill to congress.

We will continue to make contact with special interest groups to gain their support and inform them of our intent.
