THE OFFICE STAFF, has submitted the necessary paperwork for the three month extension from the Administration for Native Americans involving an additional \$15,000.00.

The 15 month program will end November 30, 1982. The Tribe will then enter into the second year continuation grant period.

The Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde has informally recieved news that the campaign for Human Development has awarded \$30,000.00 to the three tribes of Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde Indians, Coos and Cow Creek.

A proposal request has been submitted to the Earl Chiles Foundation for the continuation and expansion of the Agricultural Project to implement as a source of income for the tribe.

The pilot project provided by the Earl Chiles Foundation has been very successful.
