

#### Pharmacy

The Chemawa Indian Health Center employs a full-time registered pharmacist to provide medications prescribed by either the medical staff at the clinic or by private physicians or dentists. If you are bringing a prescription written by a private doctor it is probably best to call 370-4203 to check if we have the particular medication on hand. If you choose you may take your prescriptions to a pharmacy of your choice at your own expense. Except in cases of emergency, patients eligible for contract health service and who live within a 25 minute driving time of the clinic must have their prescriptions filled at the Chemawa pharmacy unless other arrangements for payment are made.

#### Lab and X-Ray

A qualified medical technologist is available to serve clinic patients by performing many of the tests necessary for diagnosis and treatment. Our laboratory offers a full range of blood, serum, urine and microbiological studies.

If you need x-ray examinations other than those requiring contrast media, such as stomach or colon x-rays, we can also serve you.
