On October 1, 1989, the Bureau of Indian Affairs will start a General Assistance Program for eligible Native Americans. To receive this help a person must live on or near a Reservation or Service Area in Oregon.

The General Assistance Program will provide money for those who are not receiving Public Assistance. The money is a limited amount for basic living needs. This program is intended to promote self-sufficiency.

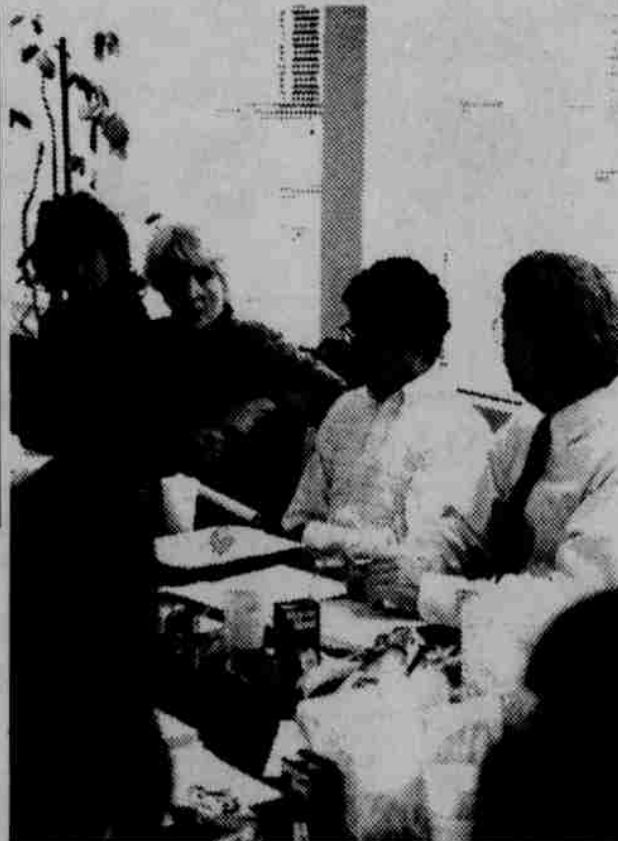
Wilma Butler is one of three new council members. **BOB MERCIER"**
