During the 1990 - 1991 school year the Higher Education Program assisted a total of 29 students from September '90 through June '91. The Employment Assistance - Adult Vocational Training Program, provided assistance to a total of 21 students during the months of September '90 through June '91. The Higher Education Program enrollment will reach approximately 30 students for the 1991 - 1992 school year. Additionally the Adult Vocational Training Program will climb to an all time high of 25 students during the '91-'92 school year.

The Adult Education Program, provided assistance to a total of 48 students between the months of September '90 through June '91. Participants enrolled in; GED, Basic Skill Development, Self Improvement - Self Esteem, Alcohol & Drug Ed, Citizenship, Cultural Instruction, Parenting & Education, Educational Leadership and Employment Enhancement classes.
