*Regular checking with no monthly service charge. You will receive our regular checking account free of monthly charges for as long as you are a member or an employee of the Grand Ronde Tribe. Limited to one account per employee/member.

*First order of 200 personalized checks at no charge.

*Annual Fee waiver on our 15.9% APR Variable-Rate Classic Visa or MasterCard. The first year's annual fee is waived for any new Classic Visa or MasterCard or receive a \$25 credit toward a Visa Gold. Subject to credit approval.

*Installment loan discounts of 1/2% below current and unsecured and secured rates. When loan payments are deducted automatically from a First Interstate regular checking account, we give an additional 1/2% off the interest rate on new loans. Does not include AdvanceLine, Visa, MasterCard, Student Loans, Business Loans, and Residential Real Estate Loans. Subject to credit approval.

*Rent discount for new Safe Deposit Box customers. We'll waive our first year fee on a small size Safe Deposit Box. Subject to availability at branch of choice.

Bigbuck Timber Sale (Pending)

Notice for sale of timber, Grand Ronde reservation, Bigbuck Logging Unit, located in portions of Sections, 8, 9, and 15, Township 5S, Range 8W, Willamette, Meridian, Yamhill County, Oregon. Sealed bids, in duplicate, should be marked "Proposal for Timber Bigbuck Logging Unit" and addressed to the Natural Resources Manager, Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde, 26930 Salmon River Highway, Willamina, Oregon 97396. They will be received until 1:00 P.M., March 1, 1994. Oral bidding will take place at the Grand Ronde Tribal Community Center, 9615 Grand Ronde Rd., Grand Ronde, Oregon 97347, at 2:30 P.M. March 1, 1994. Sealed bids may be submitted in person prior to oral bidding at the Community Center from 1:30-2:30 P.M.

This logging unit contains approximately 94 acres to be logged with a timber volume of approximately 2,832,000 board feet sawlogs of all species consisting of an estimated 2,832,000 board feet of Douglas Fir and other conifers--Peeler and Sawmill Grade Logs and a predetermined volume of 26,000 board feet of Red Alder and other hardwoods--Peeler and Sawmill Grade Logs, Wood Logs, and other wood products. The above stated volumes are estimates and are not guaranteed. Each bidder must state the price per thousand board feet, Scribner Log Scale, that will be paid from timber cut and scaled from this unit.

DOMESTIC MANUFACTURING REQUIREMENT:

All sawtimber from this sale shall be restricted for primary manufacture in the United States. This sawtimber is not subject to substitution laws. Deposits in the form of certified check, cashier's check, bank draft, or postal money order drawn payable to the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde in the amount of \$61,000 must accompany each sealed bid. The deposit of the high bidder, and of others who submit written requests to have their bids considered for acceptance will be retained pending acceptance or rejection of the bids. All other deposits will be returned. The deposit of the successful bidder will be applied as part of the purchase price to against timber cut on this unit, or retained as liquidated damages if the bidder fails to execute the contract and furnish a satisfactory performance bond in the amount of one hundred, one thousand dollars (\$101,000) within thirty (30) days of acceptance of their bid. THE ABOVE INFORMATION IS PENDING TRIBAL COUNCIL'S APPROVAL.
