Summer Camp to begin

The Education Division will be offering a summer camp this year to three age groups. Plan on signing your children up. Parents will need to provide transportation to and from the program.

Preschool program for 3 years to Kindergarten: July 17-21. Classes and activities will be held from 8 a.m. until noon. July 20 will be a field trip and July 21 will be a graduation luncheon presentation. Enrollment is limited to 20 children. Parents are encouraged to attend with their children.

Students going into 1st through 5th grade: July 24-28. Classes and activities will be held from 8 a.m. until noon. July 27 will be a field trip and July 28 will be a graduation luncheon presentation. Enrollment is limited to 25 children. Parents are strongly encouraged to participate.

Students going into 6th through 8th grade: August 14-16. This will be a retreat in Lincoln City at Gleneden Beach. The theme will be environmental education. Applications will be sent out in June for this camp. The first 14 applicants will be selected to participate.

Applications for these camps and summer activities for 9-12 graders will be included in the June mail out.

Registration Procedures: Applicant must be a tribal member. Applications should be in 2 weeks prior to your camp. Pre-enrollment is required. Early registration is best in order to insure you have a place. No "walk-ins" on the opening day, please. We want to be ready for your children. The application and health form must be signed by the camper and the parent/legal guardian.
