The Education Coordinator is responsible for the design and implementation of the educational and recreational therapy component of the program and for maintaining certification as an alternate school.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS, EXPERIENCE & TRAINING: The preferred level of formal academic preparation for this position is a Master's degree (MA or MED) or professional school equivalent. The skills and knowledge acquired are directly applicable to the work performed and persons with this level of education would not be overqualified. Course work in techniques of adolescent education, assessment, developmental stages of young people from ages 10 to 18 and Native American studies would be examples of academic knowledge acquired.

LENGTH OF WORK EXPERIENCE: The work performed by this position requires the incumbent to possess over 7 years up to and including 10 years of teaching experience at the middle or high school level.
