

Spirit Mountain Casino can be fun for the whole family

Oregon's most popular gaming center, Spirit Mountain Casino, is nestled in the scenic pine-covered hills of the coastal range. Owned and operated by the Confederated Tribes of the Grand Ronde Community of Oregon, Casino revenues are invested into programs and services for the benefit of the Tribe's members.

Open 24 hours a day, the Casino features 126,000 square feet of slot machines, blackjack, poker, bingo, keno and pull tabs. Four restaurants, including *Coyotes Buffet* and the new *Legends*, offer a variety of dining options. Not just for adults, there is fun for the kids too, with *SuperPlay* kids club and an arcade. Spirit Mountain Casino is conveniently located on Highway 18 in Grand Ronde, approximately 1 hour southwest of Portland and Vancouver, or 30 minutes west of Salem.

Cost starts at \$5.95 for up to four hours. This fun center is for children, 6 months to 12 years old, whose parents are in the Casino. SuperPlay Kids Club is a drop-in, child care center that provides supervision for children in a playland environment. The center includes a two-level soft play area, Barbie Land, Construction Land, Movie Room, Nintendo stations and Super Mac Land. Also featured is a separate infant and toddler room. Parents must register their child before entering. For the safety of the children, parents must remain on the Casino premises at all times and wear a pager. Children will be released only to the admitting parent with photo identification. Of course, there is a Party Room you may reserve for a birthday party by calling SuperPlay at 879-3901.

Arcade

Open Sunday through Thursday from 10 a.m. to 11 p.m.

Open Friday and Saturday from 10 a.m. to Midnight.

The arcade is for youth 12 years or older whose parents are in the Casino. Parents must check their kids in and out. The arcade consists of video and simulation games. Costs for games vary with each game. There is also a small concession stand in the arcade.

Banquet Rooms

These rooms are available for banquets, meetings, birthdays, wedding receptions, and other events. Capacity of 400 people standing or 125 people seated at tables. They may be divided into smaller rooms if needed.
