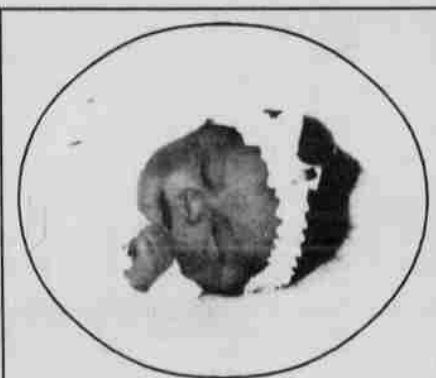

General deer and control damage season ends November 6, 1996. The deadline to report your tags is 5 p.m. on November 15. Any tags not reported by deadline will automatically receive a one year suspension. See handbook for regulations and reporting tags.

ELK SEASON:

The following is a list of upcoming elk seasons. All tags must be picked up SEVEN days before the start of each hunt. Tags not picked up by the deadline will be offered to the next person on the alternate list. If you have questions regarding these regulations call Karen Larsen at (503) 879-2376.

Second Season Elk: November 16 to 24
Trask Mountain: November 16 to 24
Panther Creek: Nov. 18 to Dec. 1
