

ONABEN Director joins Advisory Board

PORTLAND--Union Bank of California, N.A. He has work at the Native American Network, and has work with The Navigator Group, Arthur Andersen & Co., the city of Portland, and Urban Indian Council, Inc. He currently serves on the board of directors for the Portland branch of the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco, the Native American Housing Enterprise, Kimiwa, Inc., and the Oregon Boys and Girls Aid Society. Borunda is an active member of the Governor's Commission on Oregon Benchmarks Review, and is board counsel for the Oregon Native American Chamber of Commerce. Born in Los Angeles, Borunda currently lives in Portland with his wife, Marit.
