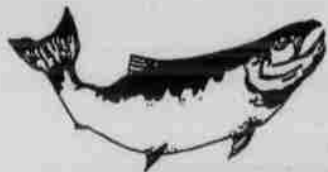

GRAND RONDE — September 24 from 6 to 7:30 p.m. at 9615 Grand Ronde Rd.

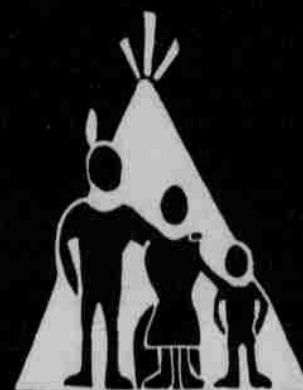
Veterans' continue representing Tribe
