JEREMY HALLER and family are doing fundraising to raise some of the needed money to allow Jeremy to participate in the Oregon vs. England All-Star Football. Jeremy was offered this opportunity due to the selection of all league defense for the 1997-98 football year.

Jeremy started playing football in the fourth grade. In Willamina they offer a Little Guy football program that includes full gear tackle football. Jeremy has played every year with the 97-98 season being his Senior year.

He has shown that his love of the sport by lettering as a Freshman in varsity football, he was selected as the Captain of the Football Team all four years of high school. During his Junior year he received second team all-league defense, and was chosen by his team mates as Most Valuable Player (MVP), Best Defense, and a co-award with another team mate for Best Offensive Lineman. This year as a Senior in high school he also received several awards — first he received first team all-league offense and second team defense.

Jeremy's coach gave him the good news that he also was selected to all-state second team for Offensive Lineman, as one of thirty-six players in the state of Oregon for 3-A football. His team mates again selected him for several awards: MVP, Most Inspira-

tional, Best Offense, and co-award for Outstanding Lineman.

Jeremy's parents, Timothy and Janell Haller, are very proud of him as he has been able to accomplish his successes in football and continue to show responsibility in academics by continuing to hold an 3.5 and above grade point average, and also works at the Casino as a pantry steward.

The family is doing several fund-raiser's to help Jeremy. Prescriptions must be filled at Clinic

To all tribal members who reside in the 25 mile radius of the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde Health and Wellness Center: **If you need to have prescriptions filled and you have insurance that will cover it in full and you are not relying on Contract Health to pick up the co-pay, you are not required to use the pharmacy at the Health and Wellness Center.** If you are eligible for Contract Health and you wish Contract Health to continue paying for your co-pays for prescriptions, you must have those prescriptions filled at the Pharmacy in the new clinic. If you choose to have them filled elsewhere **without authorization** from Contract Health, you will be responsible to pay for the prescription in full.
