

## Special topic class to focus on Grand Ronde Culture and Heritage

The Education Division is sponsoring an OSU Ethnic Studies Special Topics class entitled "Grand Ronde Culture and Heritage" during Fall Term. The class will be held two days per month through Fall Term at the Tribal Education Building.

The class will focus on pre-contact lifestyles of the Grand Ronde peoples, field trips to selected sites, the basics of collecting and preserving family histories, and discussions with tribal leaders and guest speakers.

The class will be taught by Kurt M.

Peters, Assistant Professor of Ethnic Studies at OSU. The cost of the class is \$360, but tribal members may contact Hollie Larsen to apply for Short Term Training Assistance.

Class times are scheduled for Fridays and Saturdays, October 9-10, 23-24, and November 6-7. Friday classes will be held from 7-10 p.m. and Saturday classes will be held from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

## Phone book recycling

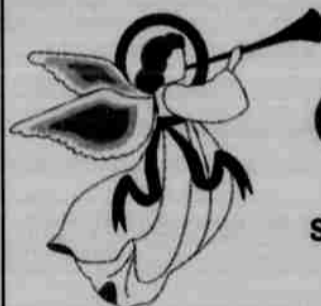
