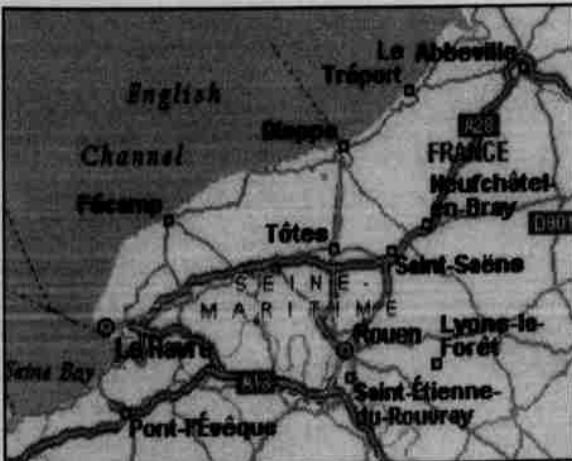
LaChance Coat of Arms

The LaChance Coat of Arms hereby illustrated is officially documented in *Rietstap's Armorial General*. Coat of Arms were developed in the Middle Ages as means of identifying warriors in battle and tournaments.

The original description of the arms (shield) is as follows: silver; two green trees on green ground; a blue upper third charged with a gold sun.

 ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE WHY
 APPLICANT'S PETITION FOR CHANGE OF
 NAME SHOULD NOT BE GRANTED

In the Matter of Pichette:
 Petition For Change of Name — Juvenile
 Merrie Grace Norling, Applicant
 by Jimmie G. Pichette, Petitioner

The Petitioner, Jimmie G. Pichette, on behalf of the Applicant, **MERRIE GRACE NORLING**, a minor child, has petitioned the Court for a Change of Name for the minor child. Applicant allegedly desires to change his or her name to Merrie Grace Pichette, for the reason stated that: Applicant's last name differs from the last name of the parent or guardian and he or she wishes to assume the last name of the parent or guardian.

Based on the foregoing petition filed with the Court on June 27, 2000, and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS ORDERED THAT the Petitioner and any person objecting to the granting of the petition shall appear in the Tribal Court of the Confederated Tribes of the Grand Ronde Community of Oregon, located in the Governance Center, room 106 at 9615 Grand Ronde Road, Grand Ronde, Oregon on **September 21, 2000 at 11:00 a.m.** to show cause why the Court should not enter judgement granting the proposed change of name.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any written response to this Order by any party to this case shall be filed on or before **Monday, September 11, 2000**. The Clerk of the Tribal Court shall cause a copy of this Order to be served upon all parties in accordance with Rule 14 of the Rules of Pleading, Practice and Procedure of the Tribal Court of the Confederated Tribes of the Grand Ronde Community of Oregon and file proof of service with the Court on or before the date set for hearing in this matter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petitioner shall cause a copy of this Order to be published in the Tribal Newspaper at least 20 days prior to the date set for hearing.

IT IS SO ORDERED THIS 31ST DAY OF JULY, 2000.
