**SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM**

**Summer Youth Employment Program**  
8 Week Program — \$6.61/hour  
Monday - Friday, 4 hours per day  
8:00 am - 12:00 noon or 1:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m.

The hours depend on designated work area or credit recovery program.

**Requirements:**

Enrolled Grand Ronde Tribal Youth between the ages of 14 — 17 years by start date. Must be responsible, dedicated and reliable. Youth coming into this program must present a warm and friendly personality and be sensitive to the feelings and needs of others.

Youth Education and Human Resources will be sponsoring **MANDATORY** informational meetings at the Governance Center in Room 204. We will be assisting youth in appropriately filling out an employment application and giving helpful tips on interviewing. We will also provide important information on the Summer Youth Employment Program.
