Tribal Elder Jesse Benjamin Bahr passed away on October 3 in McMinnville at the age of 82.

He was born on January 27, 1922 in Hallsferry, the son of Jessie and Vida (Smith) Bahr.

He served in the Army during WWII.

He married Dorothy on March 10, 1956 in Los Angeles, California and lived in Falls City, Kings Valley, Pedee, California and Dallas before moving to Grand Ronde in 1997.

He pulled green chain at the Kings Valley Mill, Stimpson Lumber Company and Willamette Mill until retired in 1992.

He enjoyed playing pool, trips to Spirit Mountain Casino and visiting with family and friends.

Survivors include a brother, Loren Holmes of Portland, sister, Priscilla Hofenbredl of Willamina; several nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his wife Dorothy in 1995; brother Harvey Smith; sisters, Arthelia Clark and Vivian Martin.

Services were held at the Tribal Cemetery.
