Montana's Native Reign Performs In Grand Ronde

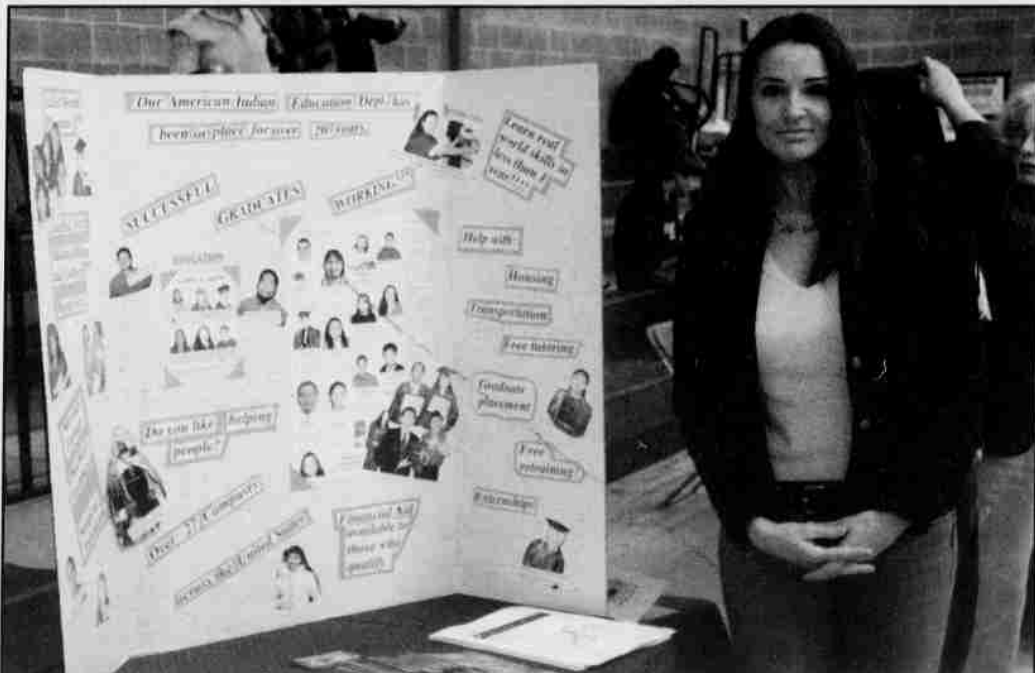
